UniKL partners with Korea's tech varsity, fostering cooperation in IT field

KUALA LUMPUR: Universiti Institute of Information
Kuala Lumpur (UniKL) Technology (UniKL MIIT) took

Under this programme, students will complete three years at UniKL MIIT before transferring to SEOULTECH for the final two years, culminating in each of them attaining a

globally recognised degree. "The collaboration will extend beyond students' mobility to include visiting lecturer attachments, further fostering academic exchange, knowledge sharing, and deeper institutional

"The transfer articulation agreement presents numerous benefits for both universities.

"For UniKL, it underscores its commitment to delivering costeffective, high-quality education while positioning itself as a significant player in the global education landscape," said Azman.
