28	Paid utility expenses by cash RM300.

- (a) Rent revenue received in advance amounting to RM750.
- (b) The loan from Affin Bank was taken on 1 October 2024, and the interest charged is 8% per annum.
- (c) Depreciation:

Motor vehicle -20% per annum on reducing balance method.

Fixtures and fittings – 10% per annum on straight line method.

- (d) Rate accrued on 30 June 2025 was RM50.
- (e) Insurance expenses amounting to RM360 is for July 2025.
- (f) Commission revenue of RM500 was still not received as at 30 June 2025.
- (g) Provision for doubtful debts should be increased by RM750.
- (h) The owner took RM1,000 cash to pay his son's hospital bill.
- (i) Inventory as at 30 June 2025 is RM19,050.

(a) Prepare a Statement of Profit or Loss for the year ended 30 June 2025.

Question 3

The following information pertains to Zura Sdn Bhd (ZSB) for the previous financial year.

Beginning inventory in units	4,000
Units produced	20,000
Units sold	15,000

Costs per unit:

Direct materials	RM8.00
Direct labor	RM4.00
Variable overhead	RM1.50
Fixed overhead*	RM4.15
Variable selling expenses	RM3.00
Fixed selling and administrative expenses	RM3,000

^{*}Fixed overhead totals RM83,000 per year.

Assume that the selling price is RM20 per unit.

Required:

- (a) Calculate the product cost per unit using the Variable Costing System and Absorption Costing System. (5 marks)
- (b) Prepare the income statement for both the Variable Costing System and the AbsorptionCosting System. (15 marks)

Question 4

Asma Sdn Bhd (ASB) produces and sell plastic plates to retailers for RM15.00 per unit. The variable cost per plastic plate is as follows:

Direct materials	3.00
Direct labour	1.00
Variable overheads	1.50
Selling expense	1.50

The fixed manufacturing cost amounted to RM120,000 per year. Total fixed administrative cost is RM40,000.

Required:

(a) Calculate the breakeven point in units and value.

(b) If the unit sold is 100,000 units, calculate the current profit.

(5 marks)

(c) How many plates must be sold to earn a profit of RM1,000,000?

(5 marks)

(d) If the unit sold is 100,000, calculate the margin of safety in unit and value.

(4 marks)
