- b) You have been asked by the editor in The New Straits Time newspaper to design a Liner Ads to be placed in the Time Connects section. The Liner Ads consists of 7 columns that is Education, Friendship, Private Investigators, Properties, Automobile, Notices, and Jobs. Design seven symbols to represent the seven columns. All seven symbols should be designed in circular or square formats in 3" size. Bear in mind the seven symbols should share a common vocabulary of shapes, lines or textures. (14 marks)
