But for this technology to thrive and make our lives smoother, there must be engineers, creators and teams of widely-skilled people to create and sustain it.

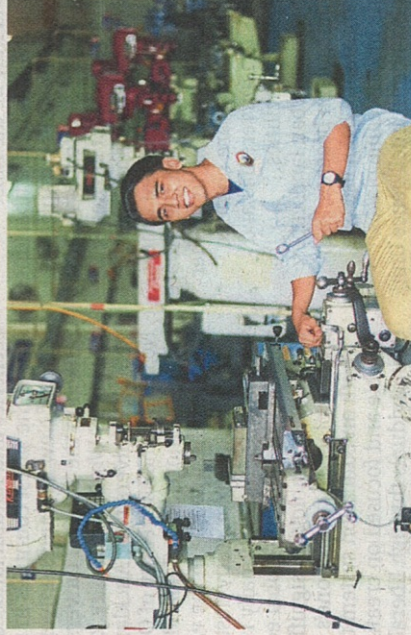
Engineering and technology are some of the most in-demand areas that present ample opportunities for future creators, engineers and technologists.

UniKL MSI also offers the Bachelor of Engineering Technology programme in the fields of Mechanical, Mechatronics, Manufacturing, Automotive and Applied Electronics.

Additionally, there is the Bachelor in Mechanical Engineering with Honours, which is offered at the Kulim Hi-Tech Park campus.

The programme focuses on all types of mechanical systems design and development, including automotive. It also deals with thermodynamics, heat transfer, structures and

materials, fluid dynamics and advanced control systems.

Automotive engineering mainly focuses on the design, manufacture and operation of engines and cars. The programme not only offers theoretical training, but also practical application where the students will get to experience machines and engines first-hand.

As a university that shares technology and expertise with Spain, UniKL MSI provides hi-tech facilities adopted from Spain.
