We hope that this book will be useful to researchers in all areas of teaching, learning, and education.

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

UniKL Teaching Alive Symposium 2021 or also known as UniTAS2021 is a biennial internal symposium that was conducted at UniKL. The symposium was organized by Centre for Student Development (CSD) and targeted all Student Development (SD) lecturers and staff under the governance of CSD including:

- Lecturers of English courses
- Lecturers of Foreign Language courses
- Lecturers of MataPelajaran Pengajian Umum courses
- Lecturers of Huffaz Professional
- Counselors

The first UniTAS was conducted in 2019 at UniKL City Campus with the theme of Teaching on the Sans Frontiere. The main objective of UniTAS20219 was to explore the teaching that goes beyond the classroom setting. With that in mind, UniTAS2021 was organised around the theme of Showcasing Excellence – Tribute to 2020 T&L Practices during VUCA. UniTAS2021 was held in September 2021 at UniKL City Campus in a fully online mode. UniTAS2021 has successfully served as a platform to showcase creative ideas embarked by our lecturers, managements, and students in making teaching and learning (T&L) as fun activities and life experience during the pandemic Covid-19 in 2020 and 2021. The symposium centralised on the idea of VUCA, which can be defined as Volatility, Uncertainty, Complexity and Ambiguity.

The symposium was conductd fully online, utilising various social medias available including Facebook, Youtube, and Microsoft Teams. The symposium provides various opportunities for lecturers and staffs to improve their digital skills and research skills, which was evidenced by the trainings provided during the Pre-UniTAS2021 Workhop. The participants are also equipped with various information and knowledge during the Post-UniTAS2021 Workshop, where the focus was directed to publish their article in any reputable journal publication.

UniTAS2021 has received 56 abstract submissions, 32 video submissions and 29 full paper submission. The best 11 paper has been selected and allocated a slot for publication with Asian Journal of University Education (AJUE) by UiTM which is an international open online refereed scholarly journal. The journal is currently indexed in SCOPUS, ERIC, MyCite, DOAJ, EuroPub, ACI, DRJI, OCLC WorldCat, and ADL.










Ladies and Gentlemen,







Coordinator, Head of Section, Deputy Dean, Dean, Deputy President and Acting President. He received his undergraduate degree in France from Université de Metz in 1992. He obtained his Master in Education (Technical and Vocational Education and Training) from Universiti Technology Malaysia in 2000. Subsequently, he received his Post-Graduate Diploma in Integrated Research Study in 2005 and Doctor of Philosophy (PhD) in Communication Network Security in 2008 from the Faculty of Electrical and Electronic Engineering, Loughborough University, UK.

His research interest is in CyberSecurity, IoT application, IoT security and BigData analytic. He is also the Vice-Chairman of Security, Trust and Privacy Working Group and Chairman of IoT Security Sub-Working Group of Malaysian Technical Standards Forum Bhd (MTSFB) under Malaysian Communications & Multimedia Commission (MCMC).

He has published more than 62 academic peer-reviewed publications (SCOPUS/ISI), including journal and conference proceedings. He is also active in Software project consultation and development; and served as non-executive Director of Skill Quotient Resources Sdn Bhd, an ICT company based in Malaysia, India and Vietnam.

Prof. Shahrulniza is now supervising and co-supervising around 14 PhD candidates, and about ten have graduated successfully.
